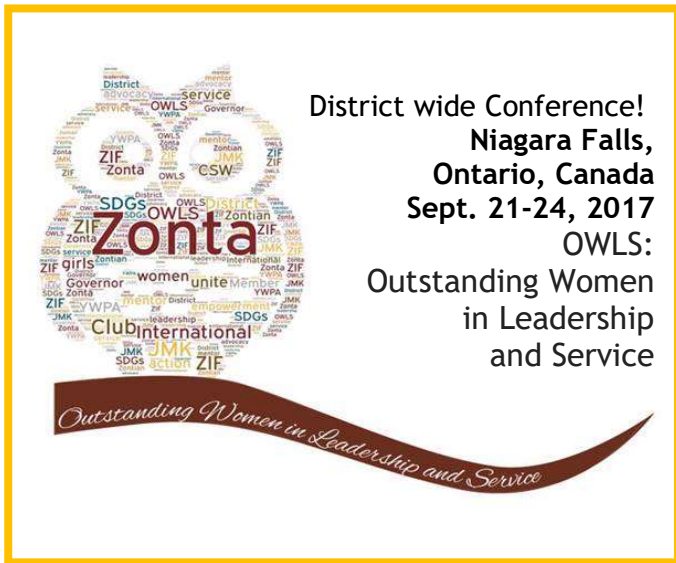
Message from Zonta Club of Amherst President:

Jean Accurso and Lynn Bender were both voted into our club at our April meeting with all voting "yea" for membership for both, no one voting "nay". Motion to accept both for membership was made by Susan Camacho and seconded by Sherry Baiocco.

Members were reminded that club dues of \$125 must be in by May 1st; late fee of an additional \$15 applies after May 15th. Please mail ASAP.

Susan Camacho, Chair of the Scholarship Committee, gave her report on the 12 applications for our scholarship. The winner was chosen by the committee and will attend our meeting next month to receive her scholarship. The field of candidates was very strong this year and from many schools.

President Kathy Reynolds called for any officer or Board of Directors nominations from the floor. None were offered so the original slate of officers was unchanged.
